The primary responsibility of the role will be to teach reading and language arts to grade 5 and math to grades 5 and 6. Since 5th grade is the school's entry point, this teacher has the unique and important responsibility of also onboarding our 5th graders to the culture, community and expectations of our school. This involves setting up clear and predictable classroom routines, establishing a rapport with each individual student to quickly identify their learning and social emotional needs (in collaboration with our learning specialist and social worker), communicating with families, working in collaboration with the 8th grade teacher with the mentor-mentee program consisting of grades 5 and 8, and leading Readiness Camp, a one-week day camp for 5th grade students in August.

Key Job Elements:

- Develop lesson plans and instructional materials that provide differentiated, individualized, and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student
- Employ a variety of instructional strategies and leverage educational technologies to meet student needs
- Establish and maintain standards of student behavior that build a positive and supportive learning environment in the classroom
- Evaluate student academic and social growth and keep appropriate support staff informed of student needs
- Keep appropriate records of student work and prepare progress reports
- Administer standardized tests in accordance with the school testing program
